

Classic Car Can Cooler

Need to make something for the avid classic car collector that has everything? Make a few soda can wraps that can easily be stored in the glove compartment when not in use. Great to take along to car rallies and shows.



Skill Level: Intermediate

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Required Software:

Amazing Designs Embroidery CD - ADP-109J Classic Cars

Supplies:

- Insulating fabric: Thermolam® cut one piece 3-3/4" x 10-1/4"
- Outer fabric: Faux suede, denim, etc. cut one piece 4-1/4" x 10-3/4"
- Lining fabric: 100% cotton, cut one piece 4-1/4" x 10-3/4"
- Stabilize It! Stabilizer: Cut-Away Heavy (ADS-7925L)
- 5 x 7 embroidery hoop (or larger)
- KK2000 spray adhesive
- Madeira Rayon machine embroidery thread
- Velcro: 3" x 1" strip (non adhesive)
- Sewing Thread to match fabric

Read through all instructions before beginning.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Hoop a piece of Cut-Away stabilizer.
2. Spray the hooped stabilizer with spray adhesive.
3. Center the outer fabric piece right side up on the hooped stabilizer.
4. Open a classic car design onto the machine screen. Rotate the design to fit onto the fabric.
5. Embroider the design.
6. Remove fabric from the hoop and trim away excess stabilizer.
7. With right sides together, pin the outer fabric and lining fabric.
8. Sew around edges, leaving an opening large enough to turn inside out.
9. Trim the corners and turn inside out.
10. Place the Thermolam inside the wrap.
11. Press along all edges of the wrap.
12. Hand sew the opening closed, then, top stitch around the edge.
13. Attach a Velcro strip along the top short edge of the wrap, by sewing along the edges of the Velcro.
14. Attach a Velcro strip along the inside short edge (opposite end) of the wrap, by sewing along the edges of the Velcro.
15. Wrap around the can and keep cool!
